County Requirements for Light Utility Vehicle Pilot Program

Light Utility Vehicles have been approved by this County under a Wisconsin Pilot Research Program effective May 1, 2008 until 9/30/2009 to be used upon this trail system and shall be subject to all the following rules specifically applying to Light Utility Vehicles.

- a. In addition to the registration form some counties may require county trail stickers
- b. **LUV's** shall only operated on designated **LUV** trails and routes
- c. Operator must possess a Valid Motor Vehicle Operator License
- d. The number of passengers carried on a side by side utility vehicle shall be limited by the number of manufacturer seat belts.
- e. The driver and passengers of a **LUV** must wear seat belts at all times.
- f. The driver and passengers of a **LUV** shall keep their hands, arms, feet and legs inside the vehicle at all times during operation.
- g. The Description of a **L**ight **U**tility **V**ehicle approved to be operated on this trail system is as follows:
 1. **LUV** means a motor vehicle not more than 62 inches in width, has an overall wheelbase length of not more than 94", weighing no less than 700 lbs and no more than 1999 lbs and is equipped with four or more low pressure tires, a steering wheel and seating allowing at least two people to sit side-by-side.
 2. Manufacturer installed Cargo / Dump box on the rear of the machine
 3. USFS approved Spark Arrestor
 4. 800cc Maximum Engine Size
 5. Operating Front and Rear Brake
 6. Headlights and tail / brake lights
 7. Noise Suppressing Muffler (96 db)
 8. Golf Carts and Low Speed Vehicles do not qualify as **LUV's**
- h. Obey all signs, gates, and barriers
- i. Obey posted roadway speed limits
- j. For the purpose of this Pilot Program a **LUV** will be considered an all-terrain vehicle and all ordinances and laws apply.
